The 1998, 1997, and 1996 levels the bus will bring all your belongings from Benedictine to the rink and you will be picked up at Seven Bridges Ice Arena after your final skate.
5. We will monitor the players and their eating habits...i.e.: **NO** soft drinks at breakfast, **NO** cereal for all meals. We will show them the proper eating habits of hockey players.
6. All players shall conduct themselves in a professional manner in dealing with the Benedictine University Officials, Ice Rink, local merchants and any other inter-related staff members.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## **1- Fire Equipment**

There is an automatic expulsion, with no refund, from TAC Advanced Hockey Camps for any person caught tampering with fire equipment or alarm systems.

## **2- Smoking, Drugs and Alcohol**

All forms of smoking, alcohol and other drugs are prohibited. Any camper violating this rule will be subject to immediate dismissal without refund.

## **3- Behavior**
